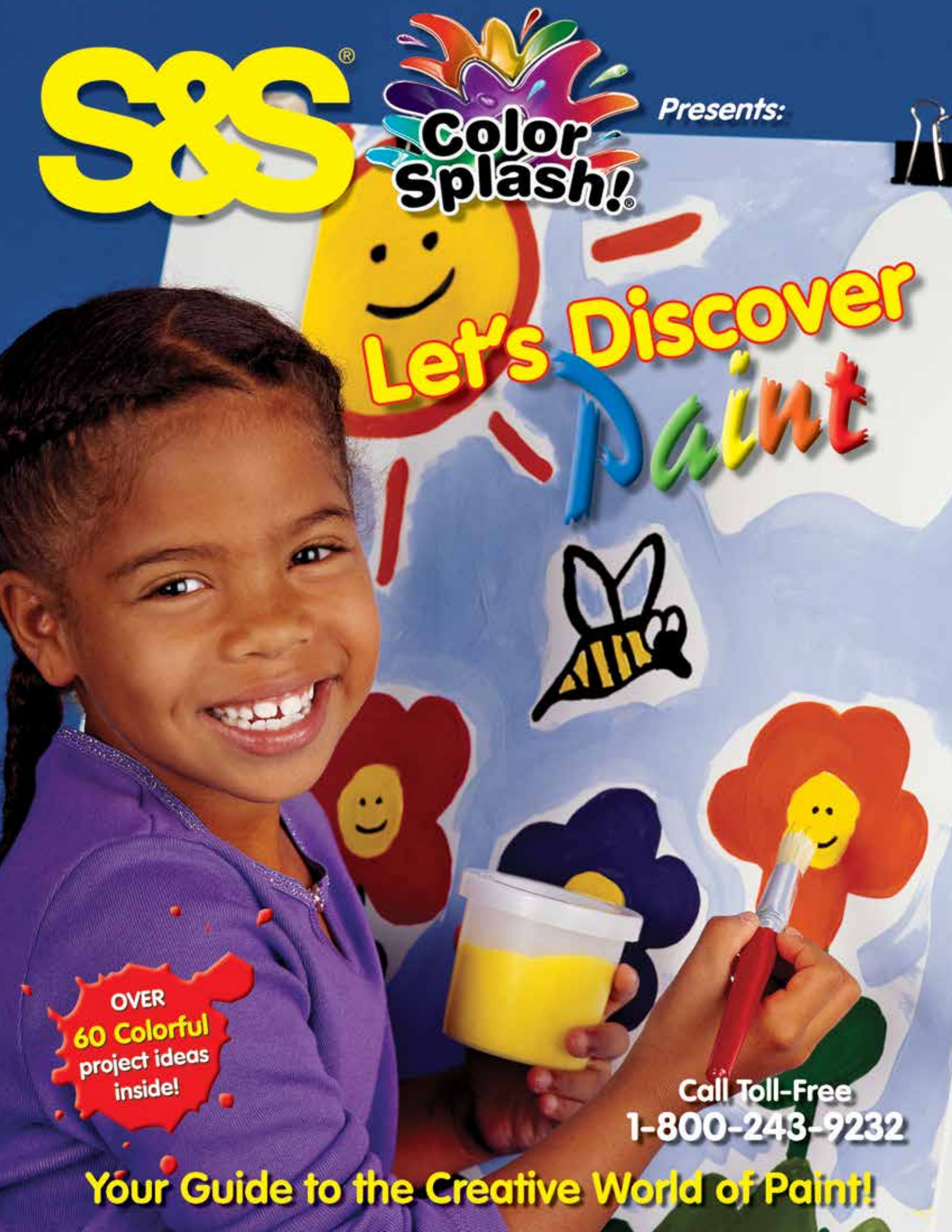

What is Acrylic Paint?

Acrylics have only been available in recent decades. The main feature of acrylics is their flexibility and short drying time. It is a very forgiving paint because it can be overpainted to cover mistakes. It is opaque, but can be diluted with water to make it translucent. Water-soluble acrylic paint is also the easiest to clean up. Permanent when dry.

Glass Painting. Mix 1 TBSP of white glue with a few drops of Acrylic Paint. Brush onto glass and let dry. The glue in the paint makes it adhere to glass or plastic. If you add a few drops of liquid dish soap, it will adhere to metal surfaces. Be sure the surface is clean and dry before you begin to paint.



Liquid Tempera



What is Tempera Paint?

Tempera paint is one of the best media for exploring color. Its free-flowing quality and vivid colors make it delightful to use. Tempera can be applied in a thick or a thin coat. It is water remoistenable after it dries. It will allow light colors to be painted over dark colors and comes in both a liquid and a powder form. It is also known as poster paint. Powder tempera is the least expensive and the most versatile because it can be mixed in varying strengths.

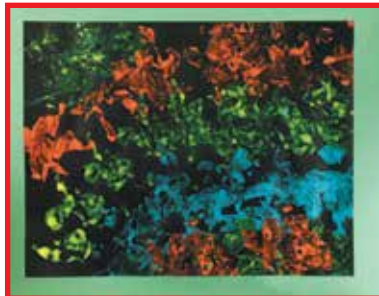

Fluorescent Tempera. They won't believe their eyes! Color Splash!® Fluorescent Tempera Paint is so amazingly bright, it works equally well on dark construction paper as it does on white paper surfaces. Invite your group to look at their fluorescent paint creations through 3-D glasses and watch them become three-dimensional pictures!

Paper Ball Painting. Put each color of Color Splash!® Liquid Tempera Paint into a bowl or tray. Cut newspaper or newsprint into large pieces and crumple them into ball shapes. Press the ball shape firmly, so that its shape stays intact. Dip a ball of paper into the paint and then print the impression onto a large sheet of paper. Great for young children. For additional activities for older children, this print could be a background of grass, sky, etc. with detail drawing or painting placed on top of the dried print.



Fun to Play with Dough! Mix together 1 cup each flour and Liquid Tempera, 1/4 cup salt and 1/3 cup water. Knead mixture. Use water to moisten if dough becomes dry or if you want to attach other parts. Adult supervision suggested.

Balloon Painting.

Blow up a balloon and knot. Dip the balloon into the paint and then onto the paper of colorful designs. The additional unique property of tempera is that you could use it to paint the balloon, to create fancy balloons.

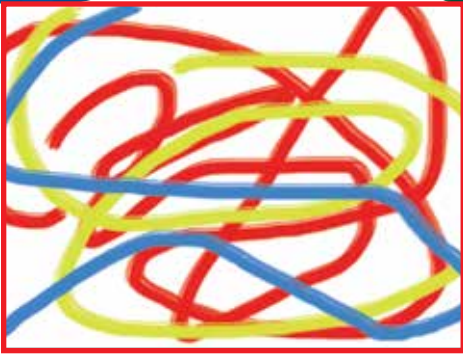


Metallic Paint Fold Over Painting.

Fill squeeze bottles with metallic Tempera Paint. Squeeze a design onto a sheet of paper. Fold in half and watch a different design appear when the sheet is opened. Additional paint may be added with a brush in order to create more detail. Another idea is to take the finished designs and cut them out, making ornaments or mobiles.

Liquid Tempera



Swirly Painting. Using a cardboard box, lay a blank piece of paper in the bottom of the box and dip a glass marble or a small ball in the paint. Lay the ball on the paper and tip the box to create swirly patterns, or try a ping pong ball for larger swirls.



Blow Painting with Craft Straws.

Create unique art by blowing paint around paper through plastic straws. Use squeeze bottles to put dabs of paint onto paper. Add water to the paint for more fluid designs. The more water you put in the paint, the better the designs will be. Adult supervision suggested.

Powder Tempera Paint - Pack of 12

Sponge Paint with Dry Powder Tempera

This may be done 3 different ways:

1. Wet the paper by using a foam brush dipped in water and then brush onto the paper. Sprinkle two colors of powder onto the damp sponge and then sponge onto the paper. A pointed round brush may be dipped into water and used to make stroke lines in the design (such as flower stems, etc.).
2. Dampen the sponge only and sprinkle with powder tempera and then stamp onto the dry paper.
3. Sprinkle dry powder tempera directly onto the dry paper. Dampen the sponge with water and press onto the paper. This will cause only the powder within the shape to turn to liquid. Lay flat to dry. After it has dried, shake excess paint particles off the paper.



Liquid Watercolor

What is Liquid Watercolor?

Of all the various paint media, working with liquid watercolor is by far the most convenient. It has range and adaptability for painting in almost any style due to its transparency.

In traditional watercolor painting, the artist usually starts with a pencil sketch and then lays down a "wash of color," sometimes in layers.

Liquid Watercolor is highly concentrated paint. The only difference is that water has already been added for more versatility in usage and techniques. This journal cover uses Liquid Watercolor on filter paper cutouts.



Flower Garden. Using dauber bottles apply color to coffee filters or diffusing paper and allow to dry. Tape leaves and flower heads onto chenille stems. Flower heads may be decoratively cut on edges before assembly.

Reverse Stenciling. Pour Liquid Watercolor into a spray bottle. Lay a cut-out shape onto paper or fabric. Spray and lift the shape off the background. Also makes great snowflake art using snowflake cutouts.



Critter Creations. Add a few drops of liquid watercolor to Crayola® Model Magic® to create unusual colors. Make various shapes, critters, bowls, flowers, etc. out of the dough. Let your creations air dry for 2 hours. Brush on a coat of varnish or overglaze after drying in order to preserve your creation. Adult supervision suggested.

Marble Clay. Use Liquid Watercolor to make lovely colors when added to white Model Magic®.

Rainbow Butterflies. Using eye droppers, drop various colors of paint onto coffee filters or diffusing paper circles. Allow these painted filters to dry completely. Paint clothespins and let dry. Assemble by clipping the colored paper into the clothespin. Bend a chenille stem around the front end of the clothespin and glue in place. After assembly, the wing edges may be cut into more of a butterfly shape if desired.

NOTE: The table surface should be covered with paper or plastic because the paint can leak through the filter or paper and stain the surface.



Magical Water Painting. Wet a small design area on paper with water and a clean brush. Place a drop of paint on the wet area. The watercolor fills it with a magical splash of color! Repeat with a new area; make sure the wet areas don't touch or blur together. When one section has dried, paint the next section.

Paper Sun Catchers. Place crayon shavings and droplets of Liquid Watercolor on a precut waxed paper shape. Place another waxed paper shape on top and iron. Allow to dry, then attach string. Adult supervision needed for ironing.

Salt Crystals Picture. Use Liquid Watercolor on a wet piece of Diffusing Paper and while the paint is still wet, sprinkle on salt crystals. As it dries, the salt magically creates unique designs.



Magic Pictures. Liquid Watercolor is great for crayon resist. Draw a picture on white paper with a white crayon. Brush on watercolor and watch it appear.



Colored Foam Paint.

Add Liquid Watercolor, equal parts white glue and paint to shaving cream for fun, dimensional foam.



Stain. Liquid Watercolor may be brushed onto wood as a stain.



Bubble Painting. Add a few drops of Liquid Watercolor to dish soap. Blow bubbles through a straw in the mixture. When bubbles build up, lay a paper on top and then lift off. Makes intriguing design prints that work well as background on paper. Adult supervision recommended.

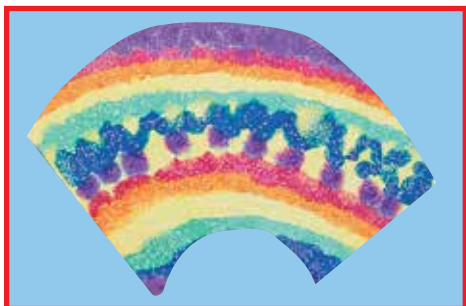

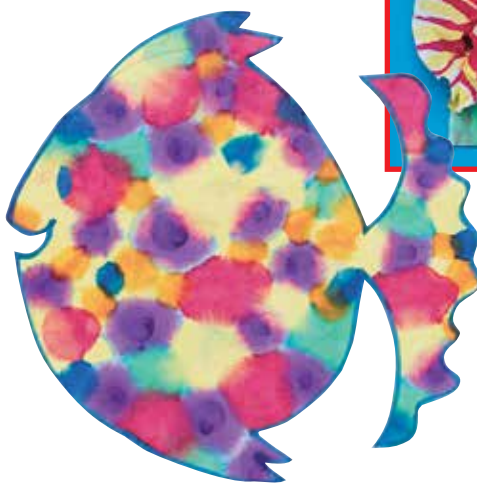

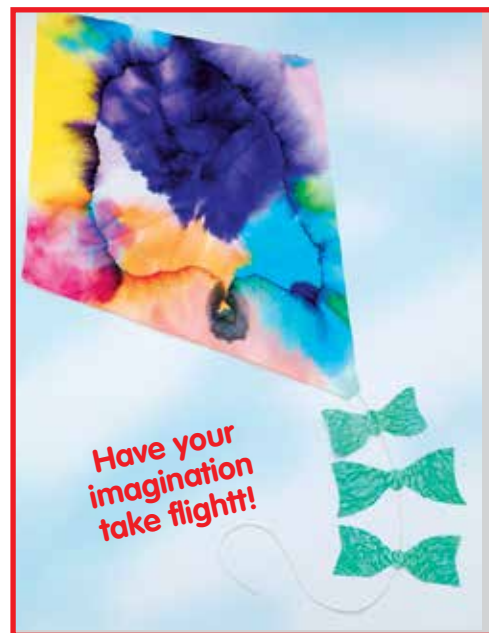


Fish Scales. Using a dauber top bottle, apply dots of colors onto Diffusing Paper in order to create the look of fish scales.

Watercolor Ink Blot Kites. Using an array of colors in random patterns, fill the area with color. Cut into a kite shape before or after painting. Make extra colored designs to use in making the tail of the kite.

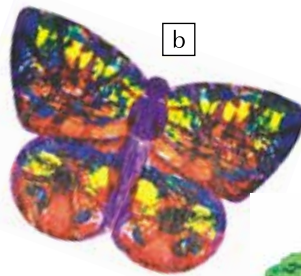

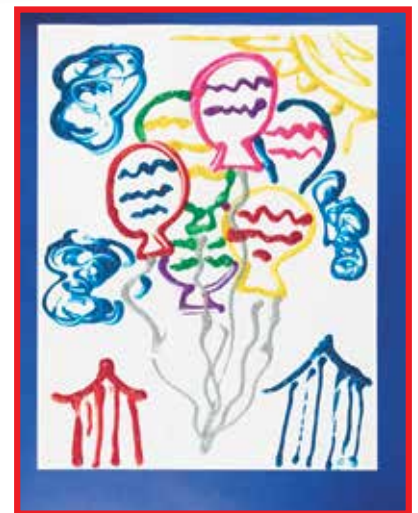

- For a special necklace, shape beads from white polymer clay, make small holes in the beads and bake. After cooling, decorate as desired with Acrylic Paint. When dry, string them onto jute.
- Customize a favorite Tee shirt with natural "stamps" – pinecones, leaves and more. Brush Acrylic Paint mixed with textile medium onto your "stamps" and press onto shirt. Let dry and wear!
- Decorate a gecko or other pre-cut leather shape as desired with Acrylic Paint. When dry, attach a pin back with Tacky Glue for one-of-a-kind jewelry.



Box Purse.

Paint box as desired and let dry. Use an awl or drill bit to make 2 holes in the lid and 2 in the bottom of the box. Cut 2 strands of 18" jute. Thread a needle through the first hole in the lid, but don't pull all the way through. Thread beads on the jute, then push needle through the second hole in the lid and out its bottom. Thread the needle through the first hole in the bottom of the box and up through the second hole. Tie cords together on the inside of the box. Add finishing touches with jute, beads, flowers and glue.

Jeans, Jean Pocket Purse and Belt.

Decorate items as desired using Acrylic Paint mixed with textile medium, stamps, jute embroidery and beads for a unique look. For a denim purse: use pinkish shears to cut pockets from old jeans. Follow decorating instructions above, then make a jute handle and sew it all together. In-jean-ious!

Creative Craft Painting



Marbleizing with Toothpicks.

On a sheet of paper, lay down a coat of Acrylic Paint with a paintbrush. Apply a desired amount of paint in a contrasting color over base coat. Create amazing marbled patterns by dragging, swirling or dotting toothpicks through the wet paint. Patterns will hold their shape to create a dimensional effect.

Scraper Painting. This paint was made for projects like this! Using squeeze bottles, apply small amounts of each paint color onto the paper. Create fantastic designs by sweeping a flat scraper through the paint to spread it. Highlight and touch-up pictures with a paintbrush, or cut out designs and glue onto the background.



Layered Art with Paint. Create bright magical paintings with Acrylic Paint! Cover an entire piece of paper with brilliant colors, such as yellow, magenta, orange and red. While the first layer of paint is still wet, apply a coat of dark-colored paint, such as black. Using a piece of cardboard or plastic paint scrapers, scrape away the top layer to create big, bold, beautiful designs.

Swirl Ornaments. Swoosh, whoosh and whirl several colors of Acrylic Paint inside a clear plastic ornament for a festive masterpiece. With ornament opened, use squeeze bottles to daub contrasting colors randomly around the inside. Then snap together and shake for explosions of color. Allow the paint to dry overnight, then continue to decorate the outside of the ornament with ribbons, glitter and other trims, if desired.

Use paint as a glue. Apply thick layer and while paint is still wet, set in lightweight mosaic pieces, string or yarn to add a design element.



Creative Craft Painting



Glue Bugs. Use white glue and paint in a squeeze bottle to create a bug on a vinyl sheet. While wet, insert small pieces of wire to be the legs. After the bug has dried, remove from the vinyl sheet and bend the wires so the bug stands up.



Ice Painting. Add Color Splash!® Acrylic Paint to water and freeze. Then "paint" with the frozen cubes for fun with frozen color. Adult supervision suggested.

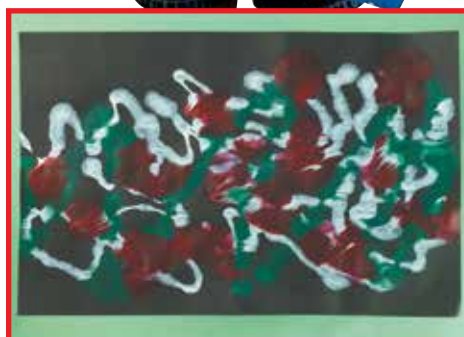
Make Your Own Chalk. Mix water and Plaster of Paris. Gradually add Tempera Paint. Mix and pour into a disposable mold. Let dry and remove from the mold. Adult supervision suggested.



Handprint Bird. Pour Tempera Paint into a tray or use a paint brush to apply paint to the palm and fingers of the hand. Press the painted hand onto the paper. Draw or paint a head and feet on the bird.



Stars and Stripes Flag. Put a very small amount of red Acrylic Paint onto the end of a sheet of white paper. Using a flat scraper or thick cardboard, draw the paint across the sheet. Add small dots of white paint onto a blue sheet of paper. Using a toothpick, draw the star shapes in the paint. Let dry and glue the stars sheet onto the stripes sheet.



Charming Prints. Pour a small amount of Acrylic Paint onto a paint tray or cookie sheet. Swirl the paint with the handle of the brush or a stick. Lay the paper on the paint surface, rub gently and then lift the painting out of the tray. This makes a great background for additional detail painting after the paper has dried. Adult supervision suggested.



String Painting.

Drag string or cord through a pan of Acrylic Paint, shape and allow to dry on wax paper. The shapes are stiff enough to hang once dry. Makes great mobiles.

Creative Craft Painting



Fancy Foil Fish. Using a squeeze bottle, place small dots of Acrylic Paint onto aluminum foil. Use a toothpick to draw scale shapes in the paint. The paint may also be applied with a brush to the foil.

Fold Over Flowers.

Pour assorted bright colors of Acrylic Paint into squeeze bottles. Fold a large piece of paper in half and reopen. Apply dabs of color (including green!) along both sides of center crease. After refolding the paper, press it with your fingers to move paint around. Open the paper to reveal a beautiful design. Cut out the flower design and mount onto a green paper stem. An excellent group project for creating a colorful flower garden!



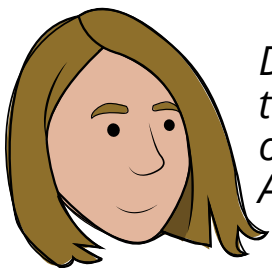
Crayon Resist. Select a crayon and paper of the same color. Write messages or draw pictures – they will be difficult to see on the paper. Brush over the crayon marks with paint, and a message or picture magically appears!



Flexible Flowers. Pour white glue into squeeze bottles. Mix in 2 or 3 dollops of Acrylic Paint. Stir. Use different colors together in the same petal. Squeeze petal designs onto a vinyl sheet. Imbed a piece of floral wire into the petals. Let dry. It hardens to form a flexible material. Shape and bend flowers into any desired design! Gather petals together and twist wires tightly. Wrap floral tape around the wires.



Flower Lei Necklace. Add a small amount of Acrylic Paint to white glue and mix. Create flower shapes by applying to vinyl sheets with a squeeze bottle. When dry, peel the shapes from the vinyl and string the “flowers” onto cording with a piece of plastic straw between each one.

Make Your Own Stickers. Simply draw an original design onto a piece of paper and place it under a clear piece of vinyl. Next, take squeeze bottles filled with Acrylic Paint and glue and, using your drawing as a guide, apply paint directly onto the vinyl sheet. Let your designs dry overnight, then carefully peel the paint from the vinyl. You have made fun, original stickers that will adhere to anything – glass, notebooks, picture frames or plastic cups. Display them on the ‘fridge! If they lose their ability to stick, just remoisten the back slightly and restick!



Adhesive Decoupage. Use Acrylic Paint as an easy, fun and colorful decoupage adhesive! Pour assorted colors of Acrylic Paint into mixing cups, add an equal part water and add a small amount of white glue and mix well. Cut out pictures to be decoupage and arrange them on paper surface. Brush a coating of the paint mixture onto the base surface and lay the picture down. Brush another coat on top of the pictures. Allow to dry flat. Create scrapbook covers, gorgeous collages and more.
